Chipper is from our November 2017 litter which was the first we raised since 2006. She started her puppy socialization class at Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club as soon as she had completed her vaccination series and passed all the criteria. At her first conformation show she was BOB in 4-6 puppy class over competition and Working Group 2. In regular classes, and her second weekend at shows, she was awarded a five-point major which was later revoked by AKC because they had held her registration "for review". This was a Major heartbreak for us (pun intended). But at the Northern California Siberian Husky Club 2018 Special Specialty she was awarded another 5-point major by Breeder Judge Ann Mariah Cook, followed by a 2 point win the following day. A few RWB from puppy classes and then a 3-point major Under breeder judge Marie Falconer. Then some minor points with minor points with even I having success in the ring. She finished her first year of competition with 13 points and both majors (that counted) in very limited showing toward her breed championship. Shortly after her November birthday we received a certificate from AKC congratulating her on being awarded "Puppy of Achievement".

She was a puppy I had my eye on almost from day 1. As she began to trot around the yard, her effortless movement and single tracking solidified my hopes. She had a black heart on her belly spot and she truly has become my Heart dog. We are working on obedience and rally hoping for her to continue in her dam's paw prints as versatile companion performance Dog.

We had been working toward other obedience titles but Ice took time out for a litter. Last December our obedience club decided to host a Farm Dog Certification test. So, on a bitter cold, frozen December morning we participated. Ice passed the components that she was evaluated on both times. However, a donkey that stuck his head out of the stall in the bard did startle her. A few weeks later much to our surprise we received the "Achiever Dog" certificate in the mail.

Currently Ice and I are taking Advanced Beginner classes and Rally Intermediate classes and doing Barn Hunt trials in hopes of adding more to her accomplishments. If I could convince Bob to do the record keeping, she could also get WPD as they cover several miles daily in the foothills above home.

My second, Micah, became my first champion. Again, thanks to Sherry's help and patience with a newbie learning the dog show ring. And for connecting me with Sheila Polk who taught me to show.

Sherry was also there for me when I lost my 4<sup>th</sup> Siberian, second champion, Lacey while attempting my first breeding. Probably why I dislike breeding so much and have only bred a few litters all these years. When I was ready, Sherry allowed me to lease one of her girls to breed. That breeding brought Sue and Richard Jung into my Siberian village.

The Jung's dog, Manny, was who I had used with Lacey. After losing Lacey Sue and Richard allowed Manny to stay with me to help with the empty hole left by Lacey. Although my heart broke from losing Lacey, at least I didn't have to look at an empty kennel. Manny and Sparkle gave me my first litter. Prior to the breeding Sue was planning a breeding I was very interested in and had agreed to letting me take a girl from the breeding. When I found there was only one girl my heart sank. Much to my surprise Sue was perfectly willing to allow me to take the only girl, Nadia, on a co-ownership. Nadia produced my second litter and my first two home bred champions.

Through showing dogs I have made some amazing friendships. One of my closest is with Judy Tamagni and her family. Judy's daughter Jessica helped me show Ashley from this second breeding and acquire her championship. Ashley gave me my 3<sup>rd</sup> litter which produced my 3<sup>rd</sup> homebred champion, Merlin, co-owned by Judy and Jessica.

Around the time I was looking for another Siberian I had the amazing opportunity to get a girl after the unfortunate passing of Judy Rogers in Colorado. Timber came into my life along with her breeders Jody and Leslie

Carpenter. Timber produced my 4<sup>th</sup> litter with Merlin and 3 more home bred champions. Logan, co-owned by Diane Willett who showed Logan to his championship, Piper, and Achilles.

When I ran out of dogs to show I went back to Leslie and "borrowed" Selena to show. It was soon clear that Selena was there to stay. After finishing her championship, Selena produced my 5<sup>th</sup> and most recent litter from which Jaycee became my latest home bred champion and the quickest I have ever finished a Siberian.

Another of my closest friendships through Siberians is with Lori Chou. Lori co-owns Jaycee and took her to the 2018 National when I could not attend. Special thanks to village members Laura and Adele for driving a crazy untrained 8-month-old to the National. And beyond my wildest dreams Lori and Javcee won Reserve Winners Bitch at the National with her co-breeder and co-owner Leslie at ring side to cheer her on. Jaycee finished her championship this year with the help of Lori and Diane. winning a Breed from the classes over several specials from the 9-12 puppy class with yours truly showing along the way. Jaycee and her sister Journee are the accumulation of all the friendships I have made over 27 years in Siberians. Friends who have entrusted me with their dogs, who have been my traveling companions and sounding boards when talking dogs.

Special thanks to those mentioned above, Sherry (who started it all), Judy, Jessica, Lori, Leslie, Sue and Richard, I would not be here if not for each of you and I Truly value our friendships through the years.
